FUN FROM DAY ONE

The PADI Open Water Diver course is divided into three parts: classroom, confined water (pool) and four actual open-water scuba dives. These sessions will train you to have fun, dive safely and become comfortable entering the underwater world. Our goal is to make you a safe diver. As everyone learns at a different pace, this course is performance based, therefore, the length of the course depends upon student skill.

Usually the course is two days.



PREREQUISITES:

- Minimum age of 15 years
- Junior Certification ages 10 to 14
- Average swimming ability

Openwater Training Dives

In order to receive your certification you'll make four scuba dives and an optional snorkel dive over a period of two days with your **PADI** Instructor in an actual diving environment. These dives are conducted at various dives sites depending on the time of year and your preference.

AURORA RESERVOIR

We will be conducting your certification dives locally during the summer. This is convent for many and is an easy, inexpensive way to complete your certification.

Aurora Reservoir has a reserved area just for diving, average depth is 30 feet; visibility 4-25 feet. In 1994, the lake got its first - and only - major dive attraction: a Cessna 310 sunk at 30 feet, creating what passes for a wreck dive at almost 6,000 feet above sea level.

In the summer, surface water temperatures reach 72F but can drop 10 degrees or more beneath the thermocline, and the bottom chills down to a nippy 55F.

BLUE HOLE, Santa Rosa, NM

The City of Natural Lakes is located two hours east of Albuquerque.

Blue Hole is an 81-foot-deep natural artesian spring. This bell-shaped pool delivers up to 3,000 gallons of water per minute and remains a constant 62 degrees. It's so clear divers can look up through 80 feet of water and see the stars at night!



HOMESTEAD CRATER

Located in Midway, Utah, the crater is completely covered natural hot spring. The water is 93 degrees year-round and crystal clear. Complete your certification in hot tub like conditions and leave the wetsuit behind.



TRAVEL WITH US

REFERRAL

If you already have a trip planned you can get a Student Referral from your instructor and complete your dives while on vacation. The cost to do this is up to the facility where you choose to complete your dives. We provide the documentation that you have completed your class and pool sessions.

REGISTER NOW -

You have 12 months from the completion of your classroom and pool sessions in which to complete your Open Water Dives. If you exceed this time you will need to retake the classroom and pool portion of the course.
