



# PADI Rescue Diver

## What will I do?

- Self-rescue and diver stress
- dive first aid
- emergency management and equipment
- swimming and non-swimming assists
- panicked diver response
- underwater problems
- missing diver procedures
- surfacing the unconscious diver
- inwater artificial respiration
- egress (exits)
- first aid procedures for pressure related accidents
- dive accident scenarios

## Why PADI Rescue Diver?

The PADI Rescue Diver will expand your knowledge and experience beyond purely recreational level because you'll learn to look beyond yourself and consider the safety and well being of other divers. Although this course is serious, it is an enjoyable way to build your confidence.

During the PADI Rescue Diver program, you'll learn how to anticipate, prevent and manage potential dive accidents. From assisting a tired diver to handling emergency scenarios, you'll practice applying the knowledge and skills that can make a difference in the unlikely event that problems do arise. There is no single "right" way to perform a rescue. Because people differ in their physical abilities and attributes, rescue divers must adapt techniques to suit the situation.

## What do I need to start?

- PADI Advanced Open Water Diver or PADI Junior Advanced Open Water Diver certification
- Successful completion of a sanctioned CPR program within the past 24 months - We have a class on August 28th.

## How long will it take?

- Recommended Course Hours: 25
- Open Water Training: five sessions over two days
- Four to six hours in the pool

The PADI Rescue Diver Manual is designed for self-study. There are review questions to be answered and turned in at the end of each section. Questions you may encounter, while reading the text, will be answered by your instructor. A final exam will be administered and a score of 75% or more must be attained.

- All class and pool sessions
